SUBJECT: Clarifications (part 1) regarding the tender for the “Provision of services for the Cruise Terminal Digital Signage System Upgrade”

Interested parties are kindly requested to refer to all additional information and/or clarifications provided by PPA S.A., regarding the questions received so far in relation to the in subject tender.

The said replies constitute an integral part of the published Call or Invitation.

QUESTION 1:

“... 1. With reference to Article 6.1 criterion 2 and Article 9.F, could you please confirm whether a company incorporated more recently than the three audited financial years requested, and therefore not in a position to submit audited financial statements for 2022, 2023 and 2024, may still participate by submitting the audited financial statements available since its incorporation? In such case, could you also please confirm whether the minimum average annual turnover requirement of EUR 300,000 remains unchanged, or whether it would be assessed differently based on the number of available audited years?

2. With reference to Article 6.1 criterion 5, and the statement that in case of joint ventures criteria 2, 4 and 5 can be met by one member only, could you please confirm whether ISO 9001 and ISO 27001 certification may also be covered through a declared subcontractor, or only by the Candidate itself or by one member of a joint venture? ...”

ANSWER 1.1:

As per Article 6.1 criterion 2 and Article 9.F of the Tender Documents, Candidates are required to submit audited financial statements for the last three (3) financial years. Companies that cannot provide financial statements covering this three-year period do not meet the requirement and therefore cannot participate in the tender procedure.

ANSWER 1.2:

Regarding Article 6.1 criterion 5, the relevant ISO certification may be provided through a declared subcontractor. However, ISO 9001 certification must in any case also be held and declared by the Candidate
