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1. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of understanding the terms of this Call, definitions of the following terms are given herein below:

- a) **"Assigning Company"** or **"the Company"** or **"PPA S.A."**: the societe anonyme under the corporate name "Piraeus Port Authority S.A."
- b) **"Concession Agreement"** means the 24.6.2016 amendment and codification into a single text of the Concession Agreement of 13.2.2002 between the Hellenic Republic and Piraeus Port Authority S.A., which was ratified by Law 4404/2016 as in force.
- c) **"Authorized Representative"**: a legal representative of the Candidate (according to the Candidates statutes/bylaws) thereof or a specifically authorised representative (by a decision issued by the Candidate's competent body), as the case may be, who has the power to bind the Candidate and also has the authority to sign and submit the Candidate's Offer;
- d) **"Solemn Declaration"**: refers to the Solemn Declaration as per Law 1599/1986 or in the case of a foreign candidate a text of analogous form of evidence, in accordance with the provisions of the country of provenance thereof signed by the Authorized Representative. In all cases where there is a reference to the term "Solemn Declaration", it is intended that such is effected by certification of the original signature of the signatory;
- e) **"Tender"** or **"Call"**: the said document;
- f) **"Candidate"**: The Legal Entities, Companies participating in the Tender by submitting an Offer for the supply of equipment and services that are subject matter of this Call for Tender.
- g) **"Interested party"** means Legal Entities, Companies which intend to take part in the tender procedure by submitting an offer.
- h) **"Contractor"** or **"Supplier"**: the candidate to whom the procurement contract will be awarded, by virtue of the contract to be drafted and signed"
- i) **"Eligible Bank"**: means a credit or financial institution or insurance company within meaning of Article 14(1)(b) or (c) of Law 4364/2016 operating lawfully in an EU, EEA or OECD or Financial Action Task Force (FATF) country, which in accordance with the applicable provisions have such a right, or in a country with a credit rating for long-term investments of at least A- (or equivalent) or higher from at least any two of the rating's agencies Moody's, Standard & Poor's or Fitch. Also ETAA - TSMEDE Fund is considered as acceptable Institution.
- j) **"Tender Evaluation Team"** or **"Committee"** means the PPA Tender Evaluation Committee which consists of senior company executives and will be established by PPA's competent management bodies' decision.
- k) **"Third Party Inspection Company"** means the accredited Third Party Inspection Company who will undertake the task of supervision of the entire project according to the present Call and its Annexes.

2. CONTRACTING AUTHORITY

The Contracting Authority is PPA SA.

3. SCOPE OF TENDER

The scope of the tender is the **‘Procurement of eight (8) 2,5 tons Electric Forklift Trucks for Cruise Terminal of PPA S.A.’** with a maximum delivery time of seven (7) months from contract date, in terms of Delivery Duty Paid (DDP), ready to operate at PPA Cruise Terminal of PPA S.A..

Note that for the successful completion of the procurement, the selected supplier shall undertake at no extra cost for PPA:

- a. the forklift’s transportation and fees,
- b. custom clearance process and fees,
- c. homologation procedure and related fees,
- d. the process of obtaining the relevant type approval and the relevant license plates for the forklift trucks in Greece, according to the applicable and latest Greek and EU legislation, as in force, by providing all the necessary documents to the competent Greek authorities and proceeding with any necessary acts for this purpose,
- e. the on-site technical and operational training at PPA S.A. premises for the provided equipment,
- f. the delivery of any spare parts, special tools and additional equipment requested within this call.
- g. The first (initial) and the two (2) subsequent (periodic) maintenance provided by the manufacturer's maintenance program, at his own responsibility and expense (materials & labor). The offer will state exactly what the three (3) above maintenance includes and after how many hours of operation of the forklifts they are performed.

4. LEGAL & REGULATORY FRAME

The tender procedure shall be conducted in accordance with:

- i. Law 4404/2016 (Government Gazette 126/A/8.7.2016) and the Concession Agreement on use and exploitation of certain areas and assets within the Port of Piraeus of 24 June 2016 ratified by Article 1 of that Law, together with its annexes, which agreement was entered into between the Hellenic Republic and PPA, under which the Hellenic Republic granted PPA the exclusive right to hold, use, manage, maintain, improve and exploit the assets conceded to it, in accordance with the terms of the agreement.
- ii. The EU General Data Protection Regulation in force (EU 2016/679) and Greek Law 4624/2019.
- iii. All relevant applicable Greek legislation in general.
- iv. The applicable PPA Contracts and Sub concessions Regulations.
- v. The provisions, terms and conditions outlined within the present Call.

5. TENDER PROVISIONS

Since PPA S.A. is a private-owned company, no objections in relation to the content of this bid invitation (if submitted) will be examined by PPA. The tender will be held in one stage.

PPA S.A. is not obliged to finally award the contract and is entitled to assign it or not, to postpone, repeat or cancel the procedure for choosing a supplier in whole or in part at any stage, without any obligation to pay a fee or remuneration to Candidates.

Where the procedure is postponed, repeated or cancelled, offers which have already been submitted and have not been unsealed, may be returned to the Candidates, unless otherwise stated.

Candidates participate in the tender procedure at their own responsibility and are not entitled to any compensation for expenditure relating to participation in the tender procedure, and for preparing and submitting the tender.

Submission of an offer in the tender procedure will constitute a presumption that each Candidate accepts the terms of this Call for Tender, has been apprised of the tender documents and information and is fully aware of the implementation conditions. In particular, the Candidates are obliged to fully apprise themselves of all project implementation conditions including all those specified in this Call and consequently submission of an offer in the tender procedure shall be a presumption that the Candidate/s: Have checked, are aware of and accept all technical conditions for the offered items.

6. SUBMISSION OF OFFERS - OFFER DOCUMENTATION

Interested parties are invited to submit their offer (alternative/second offers are excluded) until Monday 10 November 2025 at 15:00 by email to the following email address: procurement@olp.gr.

Offer submission will be completely electronically through email as follows:

1. Each offer should consist of two (2) individual folders: a. the **participation documents and technical offer** folder according to tender terms and b. the **financial offer** which should be protected with separate/different passwords.
2. Both aforementioned folders should be protected with separate/different passwords. The passwords will be sent to PPA separately at each evaluation stage of the tender to a specific e-mail which will be notified by PPA S.A. to all participants.
3. The offers' files only (not the passwords) should be sent directly to Procurement Department by the candidates at the following e-mail: procurement@olp.gr before the tender's expiry deadline with the indication: "**Offer for procurement of eight (8) 2,5 tons electric forklift trucks for PPA Cruise Terminal needs**" The maximum acceptable size of each electronic offer should be 50 Mbytes, while the acceptable type of offers' compression is .zip (not .rar).
4. On the date and time of each evaluation stage (i.e. a. participating documentation – technical evaluation, b. financial evaluation), the requested passwords only (different password for each stage) should be sent to the group email which will be notified by the PPA to all participants in due time with the indication: "Offer for procurement of eight (8) 2,5 tons electric forklift trucks for PPA Cruise Terminal needs".

Interested candidates may receive additional information or clarifications in relation to the present Tender, by submitting questions up to **three working (3) days (included)** prior to the expiry of the time limit for the submission of offers in writing to PPA Procurement Department by e-mail to procurement@olp.gr;

After the lapse of the above time limit, no other communication or request for clarification as to any tender terms may be acceptable.

Offers shall bind the Candidates for at least four (4) months from the submission deadline date. Any offer which sets forth a term of validity less than the above mentioned shall be rejected.

Participants are advised that they may be requested to extend the validity of their proposals for additional period until the contract award is completed.

It is at PPA S.A.'s sole discretion to cancel the whole bidding process without compensation to the bidders at any stage of the tender procedure.

7. ELIGIBILITY OF PARTICIPATION - PREQUALIFICATION CRITERIA

7.1 Eligible candidates for the tender procedure

Eligible candidates to participate in the tender procedure are individual contracting enterprises which are entered in the General Electronic commercial Register of companies (GEMI) or in a register of the country in which the company is established. Joint ventures, consortiums, or partnerships/union of companies will not be considered.

8. GUARANTEES

The guarantees required (participation/advanced payment/good performance) for this tender procedure may be in one of the following forms:

- Letters of Guarantee in accordance with Annexes C, D, E
- Deposit to PPA (one of the following PPA bank accounts) as a guarantee of the respective amount of money.

The Participation Guarantee Letter will amount to four thousand euro's (4.000,00 €) with duration two (2) months longer than the validity of the offer according to Annex C. The Tender Participation Bond shall be seized by PPA if, while it is in effect, (a) the tenderer withdraws its tender or (b) the tenderer declared as interim Supplier does not submit the award documentation in good time or does not come forward in good time to sign the contract or (c) the above Candidates provide false evidence or information relating to the grounds of disqualification. The Participation Bond may be returned to unsuccessful Candidates within fifteen (15) working days from the completion of the Tender (contract signature is considered as tender completion) and to the successful Candidate upon signature of the agreement.

Regarding the 30% advance payment on the net total contractual value, the Contractor will submit to PPA an Advance Payment Letter of Guarantee of equal amount according to Annex E upon contract's signature.

The winning bidder will sign a contract. A Good Performance Guarantee of the contract terms upon signing the Contract is required. The Good Performance Guarantee will be issued in accordance with Annex D by a financial institution lawfully operating in Greece or other country acceptable by PPA in favour of PPA for an amount equal to 5% of the total amount of the contract, not including VAT.

The good performance guarantee will have at least a two-year validity and must be valid until the end of the warranty period of the equipment. For this reason, the Supplier may be requested to extend the validity of the good performance Letter of Guarantee. This performance guarantee will ensure the proper, flawless and timely implementation of the contract terms and timely and proper performance of its obligations to the PPA.

9. AWARD CRITERION

Award criterion is the the most advantageous offer on the basis of the best price-quality ratio as specified in **Article 12**.

10. PARTICIPATION DOCUMENTS AND TECHNICAL OFFER

Each Candidate in order to participate in this tender procedure and in order to prove the fulfilment of the above mentioned prequalification criteria of Article 9 should submit, on pain of rejection of the Offer, the following participation supporting documents as originals, legally certified copies or valid, simple, clear and easy-to-read information where applicable:

- A.** Business profile (i.e. company profile presentation, company organization, offered products, customers, supplier network etc.)
- B.** Authorized representative full contact details (including full name, address, and email address)
- C.** The Participation Letter of Guarantee or confirmation of submission of payment as mentioned within par 8 and Annex C
- D.** Recent Economic Data proving financial adequacy (i.e. tax certificate, published financial statements etc.),
- E.** Technical Description of all offered items including warranty and delivery time, details in line with the structure and the technical requirements mentioned within Annex A of the present Invitation.
- F.** Relevant compliance with quality standards of the forklifts manufacturer (ISO 9001, ISO 14001) or equivalent
- G.** A solemn declaration, affirming that:
 - 1. The Candidate is not bankrupt, in liquidation, is not in compulsory receivership, or bankruptcy compromise, the Contractor's operations have not been suspended or it is not any similar situation under any similar proceedings, is not in proceedings to be declared bankrupt or in proceedings to be placed in compulsory liquidation or compromise with creditors and is not in any similar situation (restructuring, etc.)
 - 2. The managing partners in the case of a limited or general partnership or limited liability Company, and the Chairman and Managing Director in the case of a Société Anonyme or the natural persons exercising management functions in all other cases must not have been convicted on the basis of a final judgement for:
 - a. participation in criminal organizations within the meaning of Article 2(1) of Council Framework Decision 2008/841/JHA
 - b. bribery within the meaning of Article 3 of Council Act of 26 May 1997 and Council Framework Decision 2003/568/JHA.
 - c. fraud within the meaning of the Directive (EU) 2017/1371
 - d. money laundering within the meaning of repealed by the Directive (EU) 2015/849
 - e. corruption as defined in Article 2(1) of Council Framework Decision 2003/568/JHA of 22 July 2003 on combating corruption in the private sector, as in force.
 - f. terrorist offences or offences linked to terrorist activities, as defined respectively in Articles 1 and 3 of Council Framework Decision 2002/475/JHA of 13 June 2002 on combating terrorism, or inciting, aiding or abetting, and attempting a crime, as defined in Article 4 thereof, as in force.
 - g. money laundering or terrorist financing as defined in Article 1 of Directive 2005/60/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 October 2005 on the prevention of the use of the financial system for the purpose of money laundering and terrorist financing, as in force.
 - h. child labour and other forms of human trafficking as defined in Article 2 of Directive 2011/36/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on preventing and combating trafficking in human beings and protecting its victims, and replacing Council Framework. Decision 2002/629/JHA, as in force.

- i. Embezzlement, Fraud, Extortion, Forgery, Perjury, Bribery according to the Penal Code or crimes similar in their specific aspects to the above, provided for in foreign legal orders.
- H. Legal representation Certificate issued by GEMH or by the corresponding Registry of Commerce of the country in which the company is established (for foreign Candidates).
- I. GEMH registration certificate or registration certificate issued by the the corresponding Registry of Commerce of the country in which the company is established (for foreign Candidates).
- J. List of sales accompanied by relevant proof of sales of similar electric forklifts during the last five years (such as contract abstracts, invoices, customers certificates/letters etc.).
- K. A social security clearance certificate valid and in force- For countries were a social security clearance certificate is not issued, then an equivalent formal document / certificate may be submitted according to the local rules and legislation of the candidates country of establishment.
- L. A tax clearance certificate valid and in force. For countries were a tax clearance certificate is not issued, then an equivalent formal document / certificate may be submitted according to the local rules and legislation of the candidates country of establishment.

Note that the corresponding certificates (that the Candidate/s is/are not bankrupt, not in liquidation, etc.), issued by the competent authorities of the country in which the company is established must be submitted, along with other supporting documents requested to the Candidate/s and must be in effect on the date the contract is to be signed. If the said certificates are not issued by the relevant country, they may be replaced by a sworn statement or, if there is no provision for such in the laws of the country of establishment, by a solemn declaration before a judicial or administrative authority, notary public or competent professional body of the country of origin or provenance.

The abovementioned participation supporting documents must be valid at the time of contract signing and should be resubmitted by the candidates upon request of PPA.

All documents have to be submitted either in Greek and/or in English language.

If they are not submitted in Greek or in English language, they must be accompanied by an official translation to Greek or English in order to be deemed as acceptable.

11.FINANCIAL OFFER

The Financial Folder will contain the Financial Proposal form as per **Annex B** filled and signed. Each candidate submits only one financial offer. The offered prices will be expressed in euros (€), limited to two decimal places, and will bind the candidate throughout the validity of the Offer. The mentioned costs, as stated in Annex C, will be fully born by the candidate. Participants are requested to submit a financial offer according to the requirements of Annex B.

12.EVALUATION PROCESS

The evaluation committee appointed by PPA shall evaluate the proposals on the basis of their responsiveness to the requirements set by this Call, applying the evaluation criteria as follows:

Evaluation of Technical Proposal/ Technical Score:

Technical Score (St)= maximum total points 100, according to “Minimum Technical Requirements – Scoring Criteria” Table values of ANNEX A

The formula for determining **the Financial Score (Sf)** shall apply as follows: **Sf = 100 X FM/F**

Where:

→ Sf is the financial score;

- FM is the lowest priced Financial Proposal and
- F is the price of the proposal under consideration.

Proposals will be ranked according to their **combined technical (St) and financial (Sf) scores** using the weights
Where:

- T = the weight of 60% given to the Technical Score;
- P = the weight of 40% given to the Financial Score; and
- T + P = 1.

The combined technical and financial score, S, is calculated as follows:

$$\underline{S = St \times T \% + Sf \times P \%}$$

The Candidate achieving the highest combined technical and financial score (S) will be ranked first and will be the temporary winning bidder.

In the event of an absolute tie the Candidate with the highest St score will be ranked first and will be the temporary winning bidder.

13. PAYMENT TERMS

- 30% payment in advanced within ten days after contract signature and with the obligation to submit an equal amount advance payment letter of guarantee upon contract signature, as per the form of Annex E.
- 60% payment upon equipment arrival.
- 10% payment upon PPA SA final acceptance of the equipment.

14. AWARDING PROCEDURE

The tender process concludes with the issuance of the decision to select the Contractor by the competent authority of PPA SA.

Upon the award of the contract, the Contractor is required to:

- a) Send written acceptance of the award within three days (which may be done via email).
- b) Submit the following documents to PPA SA within ten calendar days after receiving the award:
 - i) Minutes of the Board of Directors of the Contractor, or another competent decision-making body, duly signed, declaring their decision to accept the contract.
 - ii) Appointment of a Legal Representative authorized to sign the Contract and act on behalf of the Contractor during the contract's execution.
 - iii) Good Performance Guarantee as specified in this document.
 - iv) Advance Payment Guarantee as specified in this document.
- iv) A single judicial solvency certificate.

ANNEX A: TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION

General Requirement

The electric-powered 2.5-ton forklift trucks will be capable to handle unitized cargo and ISO pallets within ISO containers with great versatility and maneuverability for optimum space utilization. The forklift must be reliable and must have been built, on a tested platform with high stability and durability, only with branded quality components in order for the operators to drive consistently and safely.

The machine must be equipped with a quick and easy troubleshooting system for operators, so the troubleshooting time to be reduced to minimum and high availability to be maintained.

The machine must comply with the most recent operator health and safety guidelines and must be equipped with all safety features that will make the operation as comfortable and safe as possible.

Safety features, such as: Load weight indicators, Stability control system, Automatic speed reduction system and Gradeability control system are considered as desirable requirements that will be evaluated.

The machinery equipped with these safety features, will safeguard smooth and safe operation, and will be suitable for the narrow and with ramp environments of port areas.

The machinery will be also equipped with overload system (obligatory requirement)

Any hydraulic system on the machine must be extremely reliable, easy to service with minimum service intervals.

The Candidate should also describe the electric system of which is offered with relevant technical details.

Every forklift will have his own charger accompanied with all proper equipment for charging.

It is clarified that additional to the above, an extra charger (spare) and an extra battery (spare) should be delivered in total, accompanied with all proper equipment for charging.

All chargers may preferably be suitable for outdoor operation.

Operating Environment

The forklift trucks will be designed to work under ambient temperature from -10 to 50°C. They will be suitable for working under any normal, rain and night operation, under dusty conditions, such as dust, grind material, salty air, fog and air with acid/alkaline particles.

The machine will be designed for continuous working time of more than 16 hours per day with one battery pack and one charging session (if this is not possible, is also acceptable to offer continuous working for more than 16 hours per day with two battery packs).

The forklift must have the ability to work for more than 16 hours continuously with one, or max two, battery packs. The time of fully recharging the batteries pack must be mentioned in the offer in order to be evaluated.

Cabin

The machine must be equipped with, a well-designed cabin which will offer great visibility (forwards/backwards), a fully adjustable operators' seat, a power-assisted steering, proper control levers (or joystick) in order for the operators to work in a comfortable and safe environment by having the full control of the machine.

The machine must be equipped with non-slip steps and handrails for safe access to the cabin. The cabin must have openings on both sides so the driver can exit from either side in case of an emergency (Open side cabin with front window with wiper, tempered glass panel at roof with protective steel grid and rear window, no side doors).

Cabin will have at least the following:

- Fully adjustable seat with belt (adjustable up to 150kg).
- Adjustable height length and tilt backrest.
- Steering wheel with spinner
- Tilt able steering wheel column
- Levers installed in steering column (shifting, direction indicators)
- Glass/plastic panes on roof (tinted and tempered)
- Automatic gear shifting, possible to change to manual gearshift.
- Rear lights and brake lights.
- Overload cut-out feature.
- Working light front fenders 2 pieces / Working light mast 2 pieces / Indicator lamps incl. hazard lights.
- All the lights must be LED technology.
- Safety special LED or laser light for ground clearance

The electric-powered 2.5-ton forklift trucks will be painted in RAL code that will be decided by PPA upon contract signing.
